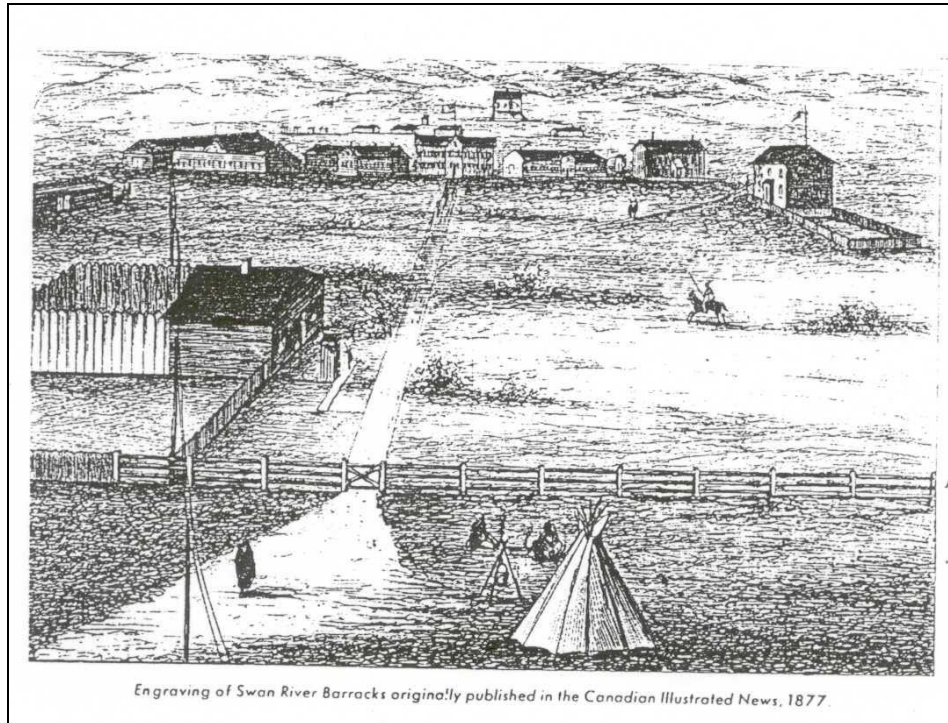

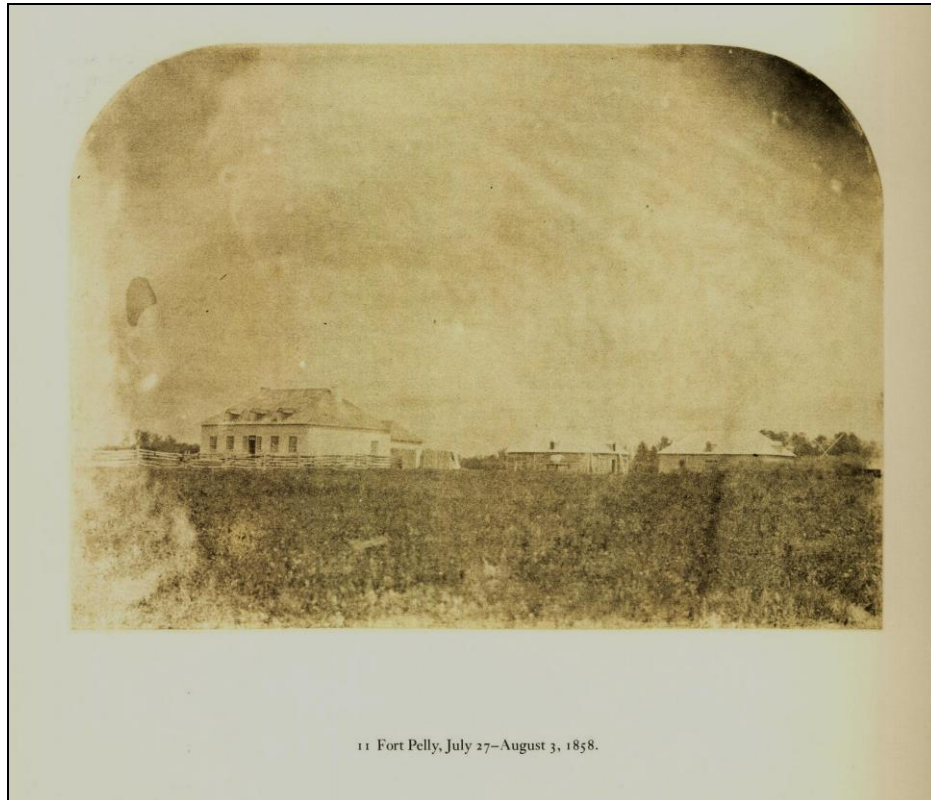

Introduction

Building design in Saskatchewan originated several thousand years ago with various light shelters constructed by the Indigenous peoples. Today, the teepee is probably the most familiar of these. Due to their temporary nature, the different cultural values of the people who built them, and the fact that teepees were frequently disassembled and reconstituted at different locations, these forms of housing have not been documented as well as structures erected during the 18th, 19th and 20th centuries by immigrant peoples to present-day Saskatchewan. Nevertheless, knowledge about their basic form and use has been preserved both through oral tradition and some written, photographic and archaeological documentation.

European building designs, which constitute the basis for the vast majority of Canada's architecture, were introduced to present-day Saskatchewan with the fur trade in the 1750's, when French fur traders constructed Fort à la Corne along the Saskatchewan River, north of present-day Kinistino. The Hudson's Bay Company initiated its inland construction at Cumberland House in the 1770's. No structures relating to the first century of fur trade operations in Saskatchewan are known to survive today. In fact, the oldest standing HBC structure is part of the former post at Fort Qu'Appelle, erected in 1875-76. The oldest extant building in Saskatchewan - Holy Trinity Anglican Church at Stanley Mission [design ascribed to Rev. Robert Hunt, a British missionary] - took six years to build: 1854 - 1860.

The first buildings in Saskatchewan which are known to be designed by a formal architect (Thomas Scott, Chief Architect for Canada) comprised Fort Livingstone North West Mounted Police post at Swan River (north of Pelly). Erected in 1874, they were abandoned in 1882 and burned in 1884. The oldest surviving architect-designed structures in the province are located at Battleford, and constitute several North-West Mounted Police post and Territorial Government buildings, erected in 1876-77. The earliest-known resident Saskatchewan architects came following construction of the Canadian Pacific Railway in the early 1880's. These include:

Hi Ross,

The fastest way to find out information on Mundle and his activity in England is to check the two-volume book called **The Directory of British Architects 1834-1914**, pub. 2000 by the Royal Inst. of British Architects in London. I do not have a copy of this, but the Univ. of Toronto Library, 4th Floor Reference Section, 120 St. George Street, Toronto, Ont. has a copy. In addition, there is a copy in the 2nd Floor Reference Division of the Toronto Central Reference Library, 789 Yonge Street, Toronto.

It's possible that the Univ. of Regina Library may have a copy, or that the Regina Central Library will have a copy. If not, it is highly likely that the School of Architecture Library at the Univ. of Manitoba in Winnipeg will have a copy, as will the School of Environmental Design Library at the Univ. of Calgary.

All of this presumes, of course, that Mundle was a member of the RIBA. If not, it will be difficult to find info on him here in Canada unless he joined the SAA. Is there an SAA Application for him?

p.s. In England, the common term of "**architect and surveyor**" does not mean land surveyor. It means a surveyor of the building fabric, in other words, a qualified individual who can survey and inspect the condition of existing buildings, and advise on renovations, restoration and alterations.

The Directory

This document is a first attempt to provide a ready listing of all people and firms credited with the design of buildings built or proposed to be built in Saskatchewan. As a reference tool, it also refers the reader to sources where further information may be obtained.

For this document, the term "architect" is broadly defined as:

any persons or partnership of people formally trained in architecture and who are officially recognized as architects by a provincial, state or national governing agency, as well as any persons or partnership of people who, although not formally recognized as architects, are by tradition or some formal documents credited with the design of one or more buildings. (This includes some persons employed by religious institutions, the Hudson's Bay Company and some contractors, engineers and engineering firms.)

The seven categories of building designers used in this Directory include:

Architect

Architectural Firm

Building Designer

Engineer

Engineering Firm

Registered Architect

Registered Engineer

Some categories have been modified to include pertinent additional information, such as "Provincial Architect", "Dominion Architect", "Missionary", "Building Inspector", etc.

The Directory has been prepared primarily from a variety of published sources, rather than original research. An exception to this is the extensive quantity of references provided by Barry Elmer, who has undertaken detailed newspaper research for all architects who came to Moose Jaw. As some sources contradict each other, further research will be required in some instances to clarify those discrepancies.

Directory Format

Those architects or architectural firms listed with an "SAA #" to the right of their names are officially accredited architects / firms which have practised in Saskatchewan since the Saskatchewan Association of Architects was established in 1911. The date of their registration follows the SAA number. Architects and firms which practised in the province before this date were not required to register, but may have been registered in another jurisdiction. At this time, the Directory does not include other jurisdictional registration numbers. If the architect also registered a firm under his/her own name (e.g. J. Smith Architect Ltd.), that firm name is listed below the main name entry, rather than as a separate entry.

Communities wherein the architects are known or believed to have practised are listed in brackets below their names, immediately after their [birth-death] dates, if known. If the location of their practice is unclear or unknown, the towns or cities listed may refer to communities where examples of their work are located. Architectural firms are similarly listed, with the [birth-death] dates referring to the years of operation for those firms. All communities listed are in Saskatchewan unless otherwise noted. Since various sources list differing dates, the dates provided here are to be used as a guide, to help place a person or firm in a particular era, and to help differentiate people and firms with the same name. Please consult primary sources to obtain accurate dates.

If the architect was a member of an architectural firm which is listed elsewhere in the Directory, a reference to that firm is given below the italicized occupation category.

The right-hand column identifies sources and references where further information may be obtained. A complete listing of the sources consulted and abbreviations for over 1,100 entries appears on the following pages.

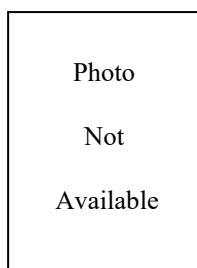

Provincial Architects / Chief Architects of Saskatchewan

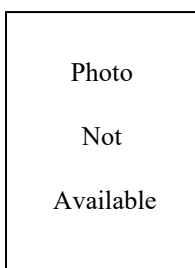

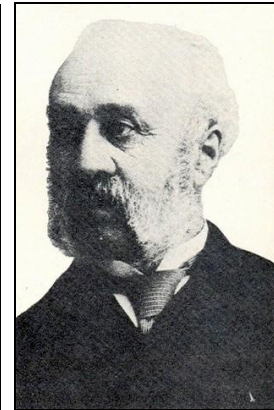
