Margaret McWilliams Awards

The Margaret McWilliams Award, created in 1955 to honor the noted Manitoba author, recognizes excellence in materials relating to Manitoba's history. Awards are made in the following categories:

- Scholarly Book
- Popular Book
- Local History Book

Eligibility criteria:

1. Submitted materials will pertain to Manitoba and its history.
2. Submissions must be published in English or French, either originally or in translation.
3. Self-published materials shall be eligible for submission.
4. The decision of the Manitoba Historical Society as to whether a submission is eligible shall be binding.
5. Multiple awards in any category may be given in the event of a tie. Awards will not necessarily be made in every category.
6. All submissions become the property of the Manitoba Historical Society and will not be returned.
7. Effective 1 December 2004, a \$25 fee is required for all submissions. Fees may be waived at the discretion of the Manitoba Historical Society.
