Mary Duncan Elementary	The Pas	Named for educator Mary Duncan .
Murdoch Mackay Collegiate	Winnipeg	Named for physician Murdoch Mackay .
R. B. Russell High School	Winnipeg	Named for labour leader R. B. Russell .
William Whyte School	Winnipeg	Named for railway man William Whyte .
