Section 9:01 of the Manitoba Historical Society Constitution and Bylaws sets out three standing committees and their chairs: Executive (chair: President), Finance and Budget (chair: Treasurer) and Nominating (chair: Past President). Council may from time to time appoint other committees and their chairs. Currently there are 10 MHS ad hoc committees: Centennial Business, Centennial Farm, Centennial Organization, Margaret McWilliams, Young Historians, Field Trip, Publications, Membership, Program, Historic Preservation.

## **Policy Requirements:**

- 1. to discharge the mandate assigned by the Constitution and Bylaws or Council, ensuring activities are aligned with Society mission and policies
- 2. to recommend policies and actions to Council
- 3. to provide regular, written reports to Council meetings
- 4. to spend only within an approved budget or with prior approval from Executive or Council
- 5. With the exception of the President and Executive Director or their designates, to represent or speak on behalf of the Society only if given authority by Council to do so

**Frequency of review**: every three years
